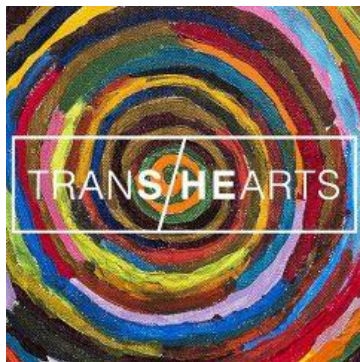
## **Chalice Circle Facilitator Training May 26, 10:30am**

## Participate in the Dragonfly stUury Hour

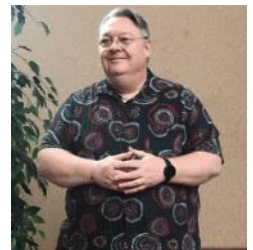
