Twilight Zone Tuesdays! Noon

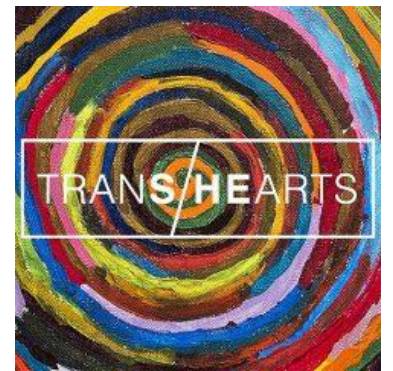

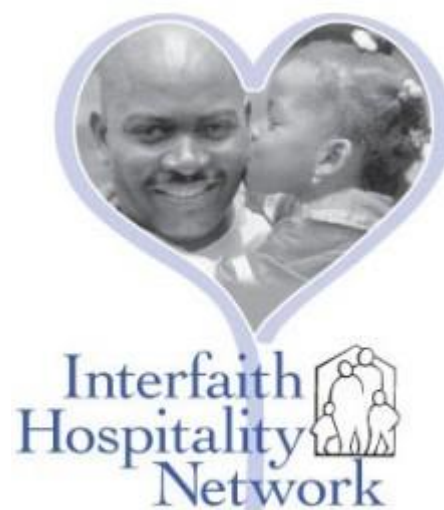
Participate in the Dragonfly stUUrY Hour
