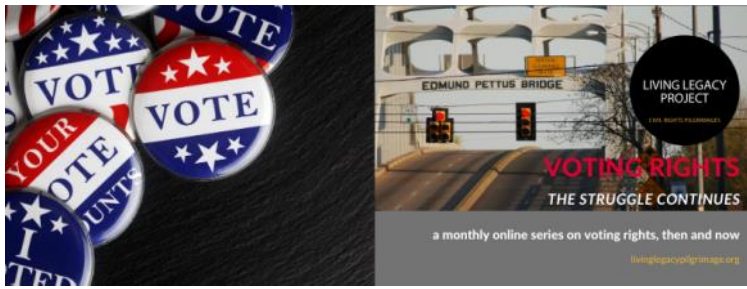

**About our Guest Speaker:** Clifton Snorten is the Executive Director of the Indianapolis Freedom School Partnership. Clifton has been the leader of the CDF Freedom Schools® movement in Indianapolis since 2014. He fell in love with this program model while attending a Children's Defense Fund national conference and was committed to bringing it to his home city, so that all Hoosier families would have the opportunity to experience this life-changing summer experience. Clifton is currently enrolled at the IUPUI School of Education where he is working towards a PhD. in Urban Education. He previously earned a Bachelor of Science degree in English Education from Indiana University, and two Masters of Arts degrees from Ball State University in Student Affairs Administration in Higher Education and Executive Development for Public Service.



Rooted in the Mississippi Freedom Summer project of 1964, the CDF Freedom Schools® program is a six-week summer literacy and cultural enrichment program designed to serve children and youth in grades K–12 in communities where quality academic enrichment programming is limited, too expensive, or non-existent. By partnering with schools, faith and community-based organizations, municipalities, colleges and universities, and juvenile detention facilities, we are able to offer this program in these communities at no-cost to the family. This presentation will provide an overview of the CDF Freedom Schools program and the role that All Souls Unitarian Church has played in developing and sustaining this program within the Indianapolis community.

The night her home was firebombed by the Klan Ellie Dahmer got her children to safety while her husband stood in the burning doorway holding off the attackers. When 14-year-old Emmett Till was murdered in Mississippi in 1955, 12-year-old Joyce Ladner felt "powerless and frightened." She felt the murder was a "call for (her) generation to do something."

Arekia Bennett mentors young organizers dedicated to making change. She works with them to address issues of voter disenfranchisement, voter ID laws, rural voter turnout, and increasing voter participation in Mississippi with a particular focus on young people.

These amazing women represent three different generations of activists. Their passion for equity and the right to vote has been a guiding force throughout their lives and work. In light of what is happening in our country today, their voices are even more important. Meet them, hear their stories, and learn about their work today in the second program of the Living Legacy Project's online series, "[Voting Rights. The Struggle Continues.](#)"
